1 CHAIRMANS REPORT

Cllr Rood welcomed everyone to the meeting and gave a brief summary of activities over the council's time in office.

**CHAPEL ON THE HILL**

This was refurbished with a lot of help from volunteers. The Chapel is receiving lots of interest

In 2016 1 funeral took place

In 2017 9 funerals and 7 weddings took place

In 2018 8 funerals and 19 weddings took place

In 2019 5 funerals and 22 weddings are booked

In 2020 14 weddings are already booked

Responses have been very positive on the refurbishment

Toilets in the vicinity of the Chapel have been erected

**WAR MEMORIAL**

Refurbishment has taken place, special thanks to Christine Brown who worked tirelessly to process this project and also was involved in gaining a grant from the War Memorial Trust

## SCHOOL HOUSE

The school house adjacent to the Parish Hall, after being empty for a number of years has been converted to 3 flats. 2 of which are occupied and a tenant for the remaining flat will be moving in on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019
