Cllr Owen stated that LIS grant decisions have been made, RumbleTums £1250 to update the wheelchair ramp, KTC £485 War Memorial up lighting, 2nd Kimberley Scouts £2315 multi use land Kettlebrook Lodge.

Cllr Owen suggested KTC could apply for a grant to cover repairs/replacement of notice boards and maybe think about Kimberley gateway signs. This to be discussed further at the next Recreation & Parish meeting

It was suggested that an application be made to Notts County Highways for a brown tourist sign for the Chapel on the Hill.
