80 REPORTS FROM KEN MAFHAM

Amanda Vernon and Tom Genway on behalf of Broxtowe were thanked for their help on the progress of the Broxtowe Plan.

Ken Mafham summarised the current state of the KTC plan and responded to various comments made. Amanda Vernon stated she has been in touch with the inspector and is awaiting her comments.

Ken Mafham will tweak the current plan to ensure it includes the supporting evidence and will submit this to KTC for discussion at the next meeting (date 18th April but TBC) This will be forwarded in draft form before the KTC meeting for any comments.

It was agreed that Cllr Boettge and 2 others would meet to produce a detailed map and also a development brief for the depot site.

It was agreed that positive policies towards the Town Centre should be included in the plan. The purpose of the plan is to provide a policy for improvement of the Town Centre and to make sure of a good development on the depot site. It was agreed that an appendix would be required to highlight affordable housing.

After the next KTC meeting an agreed plan will be forward to Broxtowe.

Ken Mafham will produce a 3rd version ready for the proposed meeting on 18th April.

He asked if anyone had any ideas for a visual for the front cover of the plan.

A vote was taken regarding the date of the next meeting, 4 for 1 against 1 abstention. It was therefore agreed that the next meeting would be on 18th April subject to Ken Mafham's availability.
