I have liaised with NCC about the request to raise the traffic island on Main Street Kimberley. Have the Town Council said what the issue is at this junction, and why they are wanting a build out roundabout installed?

From a first glance I'm assuming it may not be feasible as a build out roundabout wasn't installed originally. This may be due to design standards or cost. Perhaps if we could understand the concerns, we can look at carrying out a feasibility study.

Maws Lane is listed for this financial year, so due to be completed by the end of March 25. The team are working as quickly as possible through a heavy workload and have recently recruited additional staff to assist with these works.
