

## Report of County Councillor

I have already sent an email to the Clerk with details of two questions raised, namely, the Maws Lane TRO which is in this year's programme and the mini roundabout at the bottom of Greens Lane.

The Cadent works appear to be moving forward satisfactorily and at the time of writing this report I have received no indication that there is any delay. Whilst the works have clearly been disruptive, the traffic measures put in place seem to have worked reasonably well. I have received few complaints or queries, the major one being that drivers are ignoring the one way signage and causing issues by driving the wrong way. I have requested, when a complaint has been received that inspectors visit and see if additional signage would help and this has been done on several occasions. I hope that by the next full council meeting these road works will be becoming a distant memory.

The bus clearway proposed for Nottingham Road has passed the public consultation phase. There was an objection raised by one resident and we had a site meeting with relevant officers and as a result have been able to reach a compromise to overcome that objection.

The Victoria Street Residents' Parking Scheme has been out for consultation amongst residents and the results mean that it has passed the threshold to progress to the next stage.

I have given advance notice of proposed work to be carried out on the Hardy Street Bridge. This will necessitate closing Hardy Street to traffic but pedestrian access will be maintained.
