**VICTORIA STREET AREA, KIMBERLEY - PROPOSED RESIDENTS' PARKING SCHEME (MON-SAT 8AM – 6PM) - INITIAL CONSULTATION**

Via East Midlands is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services. Nottinghamshire County Council have received requests to consider implementing a parking scheme to remove long-term non-residential parking on a section of Main Street, Kimberley (in front of properties 57 – 81) and on the south-west side of Victoria Street, Kimberley, where most of the properties do not have access to any off-street parking

Letters and questionnaires were sent out to residents in July 2024 asking if they would like parking restrictions at the above locations. The questionnaires were sent to 70 properties. There was a total of 29 questionnaires returned (41.4.3%) of which 22 (75.86%) supported a Residents Parking Scheme (RPS). The Council's criteria for the consideration of a RPS is for 35% of the questionnaires to be returned and of these 65% to be in favour. As the returns from the residents meets the criteria, the next stage of the process is to formally consult on the proposals to introduce a RPS which would be in operation Mon-Sat 8am-6pm. The proposals are shown on the attached drawing H/JW/4745/02.

The introduction of a residents' parking scheme would allow residents to continue parking on street, but would prevent long-term non-residential parking. Parking by residents and their visitors would be controlled by permits. However, a permit would not guarantee a space directly outside a person's property and at busy times may not guarantee a space within the controlled area.

Permits would cost **£38** each (reviewed annually) and will usually be valid for 12 months, with 100% discount concessions for Blue Badge Holders and residents 75 years old and over. Details of what and how a Residents Parking Scheme works is contained in the document '*RESIDENTS' PARKING SCHEMES: What is a Residents' Parking Scheme?*' which was sent out with the original questionnaires. If you require another copy of the guide then this can either be sent to you by post or by e-mail. Only once the consultation process is completed will you be given the opportunity to apply for a permit(s).

This letter is part of the initial consultation to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter before the scheme is publicly advertised. Any suggested changes to the scheme could be made before the public advert is sent out. If you wish to make any comments or suggest any alterations can you please submit your response before **3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024** using the e-mail or postal address at the bottom of the letter.
