

## **Cllr Andy Cooper's Report**

My case work has involved:

I'm still involved with a resident who is complaining about their neighbour land filling on green belt. They have been informed to contact the Environment Agency ASAP. As regards activities on site at their neighbour's premises, Broxtowe's planning enforcement officer is investigating.

Following up on a resident's claim that a skip adjacent his premises could contain asbestos.

The skip is used by a roofer who lives nearby. Environmental Health and Control at Broxtowe have been informed and I have been told that the roofer is on the council's radar after multiple complaints by neighbours.

I've written to Fairgrove yet again regarding a dissatisfied resident who came back from holiday to find water leaking into their living room.

They have lived there for 5 years and several attempts to rectify the problem have failed.

I've successfully appealed a parking charge notice that was issued to an 87 year old lady who had failed to display her disabled badge in a disabled parking bay in Victoria St car park. I was in a meeting at Rumbletums when I was called outside to help the lady who was extremely distressed when the Enforcement Officer informed her of the offence.

I have reported a Land Rover to Gerard which has been parked in a dangerous location on Maws Lane for weeks. I was informed that it had possibly been abandoned but the police have informed me that it is taxed and legal.

I have received thanks from a resident after facilitating a face to face meeting with our MP Alex Norris where she was able to discuss a personal issue.
