What does your group / organisation do?	<p><i>The club provides bowling for local residents to enjoy an active sport, to keep fit, to socialize and to enjoy competition.</i></p> <p><i>The Kimberley Bowls Club caters for the recreational needs of mainly, but not exclusively, the more senior people of the Kimberley area in that it provides a very pleasant location and facilities to enjoy socialising and keeping fit and healthy by playing bowls.</i></p> <p><i>In April of each year the club arranges an Open Weekend where anyone from Kimberley can attend, try out playing bowls and if sufficiently interested, sign up to become a member of the club.</i></p> <p><i>Each year the club organises several "in house" competitions throughout the season and also has several teams which play in local leagues on different days of the week playing host to visiting teams on both afternoon and evening games throughout each week.</i></p> <p><i>Throughout the year club hosts 28 Home League Games with visiting teams coming to play and the club also participates in the corresponding 28 Away matches playing at venues around the Nottinghamshire area.</i></p> <p><i>The ground is also open for two practise afternoons each week where members can hone their skills either individually or in a group. On the practise afternoon the club is open to local residents</i></p>

		<p><i>and offers an opportunity for them to enjoy socialising and also keep fit and active whilst enjoying bowls.</i></p> <p><i>The Bowling Green, the grounds and the clubhouse are owned by the Kimberley Town Council / Kimberley Miners Recreation Ground Trust and whilst this is true, many of the club members, without pay, care for and maintain the green in excellent playing condition and also make sure that both the club house and storage container are kept in a clean, tidy and pristine fashion.</i></p>
