

## County Councillor Report Full Council 24<sup>th</sup> April 2025

Despite the upcoming election the day to day work continues. I continue to report, and have filled, pot holes where they occur. A number of locations have been reported in the last couple of weeks namely, Edgewood Road, Clifton Drive, Stocks Road and ones around the min-roundabout. I urge all members to make use of the the very effective 'My Notts' app which allows members of the public to report potholes, pavement damage and other incidents direct, rather than feed it though a member of council, though I am always happy to pursue an issue on behalf of any resident. The advantage of the 'My Notts' app is that it gives feedback to the person putting in the report and lets them know when the work has been completed or whether further work needs to be carried out.

Via have attended to a depression that occurred on Gilthill and were trying to ascertain the causes of the sinking of the road. I have not had any feedback on this as yet. Patching work has been completed on Awsworth Lane and Goodwin Drive and I continue to press for the patching of the section of Main Road between James Street and Nine Corners.

I updated members on the progress of the TRO for Maws Lane. The sooner it is introduced the better as the dangerous parking continues unabated at the moment.

The big issue that will be faced by the County Council, going forward is the whole issue of local government re-organisation. I have been advised that the Government's response to the proposals submitted from Nottinghamshire, is expected on the 2nd May. Whether they meet that deadline remains to be seen. The incoming administration at County Hall/Oak House will have to ponder carefully, its next steps when the Government's response is received.
