

Cllr Andy Cooper Report Full Council 24th April 2025

I have contacted Notts County Council Social Services Safeguarding team after being informed that an elderly resident (89) required some form of assistance. The safeguarding team have visited the resident concerned and is organising a care plan.

I have contacted the housing team at Broxtowe after being contacted by a resident seeking rehousing owing to domestic circumstances and medical issues.

Fly tipping continues to be a problem in the Bassett Close, Ruislip Close area. The Broxtowe depot team have removed some. In the same area, uneven pathways are being replaced by concrete walkways

Residents living on Cloverlands have raised Health & Safety issues regarding overgrown trees adjacent and overhanging their properties. I accompanied the Broxtowe depot team who came and assessed the issue. They agreed that it was definitely a H & S issue but could not give a definite date on addressing the issue. The tree officer has retired and has not yet been replaced. Some of the trees have TPOs but they can be "crowned". Broxtowe depot team will keep in touch with residents.

I'd like to inform the council that two residents of Kimberley were recently awarded British Empire Medals. I had the pleasure of attending the ceremony as I had nominated one recipient (Dr David Nunn, former chairman of KTC) for a national award 8 years ago!
